

## Conference: Dissemination of the International Cooperation and Technical Assistance Department of the University of Panama, Campus.

The University of Panama, considering the importance of Internationalization for the University Community, has framed according to the institutional policies defined in its Strategic Plan, specifically, in its axis number seven (7), the implementation of strategic proposals and specific objectives, to highlight a greater momentum in the processes of internationalization of the House of Higher Studies of Octavio Méndez Pereira for knowledge management.

In this sense, the Directorate of International Cooperation and Technical Assistance (DICIAT), last April, held at the Central Campus of the University of Panama, the Conference on the Disclosure and Internationalization of the Projects that are being carried out, from this address.

The activity was aimed at teachers, students and administrative staff, managing to inform and promote student, academic, teaching and administrative mobility programs that are carried out under the coordination of DICIAT.

In this activity were explained the program and activities that are under development between DICIAT and the European Union Project, called "Strengthening of Internationalization" (FORINT), which contributes to the development, strengthening of programs and networks of research of the University of Panama.

Also, the agreements and agreements in force between the University of Panama and the different foreign Higher Education Institutions were announced. As well as the procedure and documentation required for the formulation of new agreements.

The guidelines to be followed for requests for academic trips abroad, such as the requirements, documents and reports that must be submitted by applicants, were also provided.

Thus, the Directorate for International Cooperation and Technical Assistance, managed to bring the update information to more than two hundred and fifty (250) people among professors, students and administrators of the different Regional Centers and University Extension visited.

Finally, to the teachers links of each academic unit as well as its Directors.

The most outstanding faculties in participation during the days held in this period of the year were the Faculty of Public Administration, Fine Arts, Computer Science, Dentistry, Agricultural Sciences, Social Communication, Business Administration and Accounting; Nursing,
