



Workshop: “Development of guidelines for internationalization”.

University of Camagüey, Cuba. 22-24 October, 2018

On 22, 23 and 24 of October 2018, the representatives of the different participating universities in the Project FORINT attended the workshop on Development of guidelines for Internationalization. As part of the Work Package 4 “Roadmaps for Internationalisation”, and under the mentoring of European experts, all participants (Cuba and Panama) have the opportunity to begin the road map of the internationalization of their universities. Mission, vision and other concepts were analyzed as all the process for the implementation of their strategies. Also they preview the resources and the control mechanisms.

Dra. Fiona Hunter, Associate Director at the Centre for Higher Education Internationalisation (CHEI) at the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore in Milan, Italy, delivered the seminar which allowed the participants to get familiar with the concept of Road Maps. Dr. Alfonso Esparza, Rector of the University of Camagüey, also presented the campus “Ignacio Agramonte Loynaz” to the Panamanian, Cuban and European delegation and he was in charge of delivering certificates of participation to the students attending the workshop.

The participants began to develop new concepts and definitions for the key concepts of the process of internationalization of their universities based on the definitions and criteria explained.
