Seminar: “International Projects and Project management”.

Holguín, 13 – 15 December 2017

On 13, 14 and 15 December 2017, the representatives of the different participating universities in the Project FORINT attended the seminar on International Projects and Project management. As part of the Work Package 2 “Trainings on internationalisation at strategic level”, the seminar offered to the participants an opportunity to discuss and share best practices on the submission, management and international coordination of international projects.

Dr. Reynaldo Velázquez Zaldívar, Rector of the University of Holguín, opened the seminar and presented the campus “Celia Sanchez Manduley” to the Panamanian, Cuban and European delegation. Dr. Roberto Escarré y Dr. Ester Boldrini, respectively Director and Vice-Director of the International Projects office of the University of Alicante, delivered the seminar which allowed the participants to get familiar with the Programme Erasmus + of the European Union and the possibilities for cooperation for Latin America, in particular for Capacity-Building Projects for Higher Education.

With theoretical references on project cycle management, project creation and consortium management and practical exercises, the participants developed new ideas for international projects and international cooperation to support the internationalization strategy of their university.

Mr. Jean-Baptiste Maillard (Project manager, EFMD), Dr. Mabelin Armenteros (Internationalisation director of the Agrarian University of Havana) and Dr. Reynaldo Velazquez Zaldivar (Rector of the University of Holguin) concluded the seminar and recalled the importance of international projects for the development of new cooperation schemes between universities and the opportunities offered by the European Union in this field.
